

Welcome to Byron Bay Ladies Tournament 2021



Thank you for supporting our Tournament. Our planning this year has been somewhat short-notice in light of all those recent 'uncertainties'. The Good News is we're ready to go.....

Our Covid Safe Golf Rules:

- As already advised all playing in our Tournament must be fully vaccinated
- Do not come to the golf club or course if you have any symptoms or feel unwell. Stay at home and get tested
- All players must register via QR code on arrival
- All players must carry proof of their vaccination status
- Do Not Touch the Flagstick
- No rakes in bunkers - **but bunkers are still in play**, using the Covid-Golf modification of a preferred lie of 1 card length. Please smooth the bunker with your shoes. Also please note: enter and exit points to bunkers are marked with white paint - please do not walk up the face of any bunker unless playing a shot
- Maintain social distance protocols and do not shake hands
- Practice areas will be open

Scorecards: Please swop scorecards with a playing partner. At the end of the round please check cards carefully, and especially that crosses and scores match. There will be a box for submitting cards in the Clubhouse. Our Committee will process the cards through the scanners.

On Friday we will be using a single card; hopefully most are 'semi-familiar' with these cards where it is just the best ball score (on a first-in basis) that is recorded and assigned as per Player 1 or Player 2. And please note if both players have a 'Pick-up' you do need to mark a cross under P1 or P2.

Catering: Lunch is included both days. Please make your selection from the daily menu before golf; ideally if you're playing both days please order for both days on the Thursday. At Thursday presentations we hope you will all enjoy a (free) glass of wine and nibbles.

Now to the Golf: Divisions (ie playing handicap, Byron Bay Ladies Red) for Thursday are:

Division 1: 0 – 19 Division 2: 20 – 23 Division 3: 24 – 30 Division 4: 31 – 45

As you will see when you check the timesheet, we are having a 4-tee start on Thursday. This worked well last year so can I please remind you to play **Ready Golf**, and if you're playing stableford to pick up if you cannot score, so that we all aim to complete our round in a maximum 4 hours 15 minutes.

Friday is a shotgun start at 8.30am: We will need to avoid 'crowding' before golf so please only one of each pair registering. Friday's draw will be posted in the Clubhouse on Thursday.

Carts: Everyone who requested a cart will have a ride. For Thursday we have in some cases allocated a cart share so that the field is approximately playing in handicap divisions.

We hope you enjoy our course and our hospitality.
